ELIGIBILITY & RULES

Events: All events and tentative times are included in this packet.

Rules: This competition will be run in accordance with the latest rules and requirements as published by the ISI National office. All coaches, judges and participants should be familiar with the ISI requirements.

Eligibility: This competition is open to all current ISI members only, up to and including the date of the competition. All competitors must compete at their highest test level passed and all tests must be registered with the ISI National office at least 30 days prior to the event. All competitors must represent a current ISI administrative arena.

Skaters are expected to compete at their true ability level and to uphold high ethical standards.

If a US skater has passed the following FS test, they may compete no lower in IS then:

Preliminary	Freestyle 4	Open Silver FS
Pre-Juvenile	Freestyle 4	Open Silver FS
Juvenile	Freestyle 6	Open Gold FS
Intermediate	Freestyle 6	Open Gold FS
Novice	Freestyle 7	Open Platinum FS
Junior	Freestyle 8	Open Platinum FS
Senior	Freestyle 8	Open Platinum
Adult Bronze	Freestyle 3	Open Bronze FS
Adult Silver	Freestyle 4	Open Silver FS
Adult Gold	Freestyle 5	Open Gold FS

These are the minimum requirements and USFS Moves in the Field tests have no bearing on any ISI test level. USFS adult skaters, age 21 and older may petition the competition director for permission to compete lower then levels listed above.

Verification: All skaters test levels and membership will be verified through the ISI office prior to the competition. The team coach must sign all entry forms to indicate that the information on the form is correct.

Music: CD's and Cassette tapes will be accepted. Tapes should be rewound and must have proper label on the correct side of the tape with the skater's name. Music should be handed in 1 hour prior to the event and all skaters should have a back up of their music just in case. Dancers may provide their own music for each dance or use music provided from Babson. If a skater is doing multiple dance please put all music on separate CD's/Cassettes.

Awards: Awards will be given for all placements.

Entry Fees: Skaters should make their checks payable to their home club and the team coach will send one check with all applications and judges forms in a single packet to the host rink.

Stroking: Competitors will pick up numbers at registration and check in with the Ice Capt. 30min prior to the event.

Directions: Babson Skating Center 150 Great Plain Avenue: Wellesley, MA 02181

From I-95/Route 128 Southbound:

- Take I-95/Route 128 South to Exit 21B (Route 16 West towards Wellesley)
- Take a right off the exit ramp onto Route 16 West (Washington St.)
 - Follow Route 16 West for 1.5 miles
 - Take a left onto Route 135 East towards Needham
 - Stay on Route 135 past the rotary and up a hill
- You will see a sign for the Babson Skating Center on your left.
- The skating center is located next to the Boston Sports Club.

From I-95/Route 128 Northbound:

- Take I-95/Route 128 North to Exit 18 (Great Plain Avenue)
- Take a right off the exit ramp onto Great Plain Avenue towards Needham
 - Follow Great Plain Avenue for 3.8 miles
- The skating center is on the right .3 miles after the entrance to Olin College.
- The skating center is located next to the Boston Sports Club.

From Route 9 Westbound:

- Take Route 9 West to the Wellesley Exit (Route 16)
- You will see signs directing you towards Babson College
 - Take a left onto Route 16 West (Washington St.)
 - Follow Route 16 West for approximately 1/4 mile
 - Take a left onto Route 135 East towards Needham
 - At rotary take your first right towards Olin College
- You will see a sign for the Babson Skating Center on your left.
- The skating center is located next to the Boston Sports Club.
